ALEXANDER MACOMB



Dominating the emblem of Macomb County is the County outline flanked by a sailboat and three gears, which represent recreation and industry, two of the County's greatest assets. The banner traversing the County's outline represents progress. The date, 1818, is the year MACOMB COUNTY was established. Circumscribing the emblem are the words "MACOMB COUNTY" AND "MICHIGAN", separated by a five pointed star,
