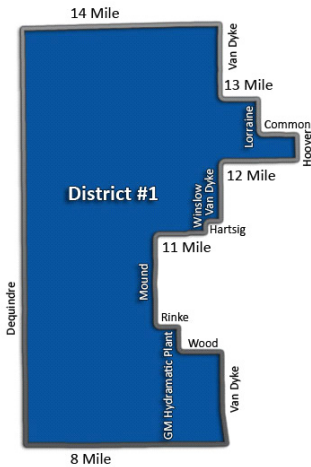

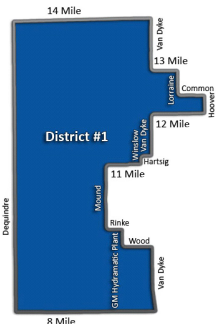


Board Meetings are Just Clicks Away

Can't make it to a public meeting in person, but want to stay informed?

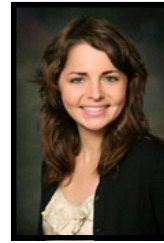
