Master Composter Class

MSU Extension (MSUE) is offering a six-week Master Composter course on Thursdays, October 6 through November 10, 2011, from 6:30 to 9 p.m. Classes will be held at the VerKuilen Building, 21885 Dunham Road, Clinton Township. The course is \$45, which includes 15 hours of instruction by MSU staff and local compost professionals and the Master Composter resource notebook.
