Origin: PA 280 ('39) MCL 400.45 and MCL 400.46

Function: The function of the county Family Independence Agency is to administer programs that provide financial assistance, medical assistance and social services to eligible county residents. As a state agency, it is responsible for administering Federal and/or State funded programs including Family Independence Program (formerly ADC), food assistance, state emergency relief, Medicaid, delinquency, foster care, adoption, licensing, adult social services, protective services and employment and training services. In addition, the County provides assistance and administrative funding for resident county hospitalization, county emergency assistance and County foster care. MCL §400.45 requires the existence of the board.
