

Building Authority

The Building Authority was incorporated as a non-profit Authority for the purpose of acquiring, furnishing, equipping, owning, improving, enlarging, operating and maintaining a building or buildings and automobile parking lots or structures and necessary site or sites therefore for the use of the County of Macomb.¹ In acquiring property, it may do so by purchase, construction, lease, gift, devise or condemnation.² In addition, it may issue self-liquidating revenue bonds provided that such bonds shall be payable solely from the revenues of such property.³ The Macomb County Building Authority was created pursuant to MCL§123.951. The Articles of Incorporation provide that compensation may be authorized by the Board of Commissioners.
