

## Social Services Board

Provides The function of the county Social Services Board is to administer programs that provide financial assistance, medical assistance and social services to eligible county residents. As a state agency, it is responsible for administering Federal and/or State funded programs including Family Independence Program, food assistance, state emergency relief, Medicaid, delinquency, foster care, adoption, licensing, adult social services, protective services and employment and training services. In addition, the County provides assistance and administrative oversight for resident county hospitalization, county emergency assistance and County foster care.
