

Medical risk conditions are similar for both seasonal and 2009 novel H1N1 influenza and include:

- Children 6 months – 18 years on long-term aspirin therapy
- Persons with the following conditions or disorders:
 - Chronic pulmonary (including asthma)
 - Cardiovascular (except hypertension)
 - Renal or hepatic
 - Neurologic or neuromuscular
 - Hematologic or metabolic (including diabetes)
 - Immunosuppression (including that caused by medications or HIV)
