Community Connection Day to assist homeless and people at risk of homelessness

Mount Clemens, Mich. – A Community Connection Day to connect people in need with resources takes place Wednesday, January 26. The event is being held at the Mount Clemens Community Center, 300 N. Groesbeck Hwy. from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Macomb County residents who are homeless or at risk of homelessness are invited to attend this event hosted by the Macomb Homeless Coalition.

Representatives from organizations providing homeless prevention services, emergency shelter, housing programs and searches, health screenings, food programs, youth and student services, legal services, Social Security assistance, and other resources will be available. Attendees are also able to obtain influenza vaccinations, clothing, haircuts and lunch.
