

Macomb Urban County Request for 2009 CDBG Proposals

The Urban County of Macomb seeks proposals from qualified non-profit agencies in its 21-community jurisdiction. Proposals must address one of the following objectives:

- Assist the homeless, or prevent homelessness among at-risk populations, including those with special needs; or provide strategic planning services to address such needs.
- Provide or expand services to lower income people, including those with special need and those at-risk of homelessness.
- Improve a community resource.

Proposals must be: 1) submitted on the prescribed form, 2) complete and properly executed, and 3) received by the County by 5:00 pm, December 5, 2008. Current CDBG recipients must also demonstrate a need for additional funding and have submitted all required reports.

A workshop will be held at the Ver Kuilen Center, 21885 Dunham Rd., Clinton Township, at 9:30 on Thursday, October 31 to review guidelines and evaluation criteria and receive forms, which may also be obtained at www.macombbusiness.com.
