The Bill Collins Outstanding Horsemanship Award is given to a 4-H horse project member. It is awarded yearly and is based on the nominee's overall involvement in 4-H and the 4-H Horse Program.

### Criteria for nomination:

A 4-H member to be considered for this award should be nominated by a 4-H leader. A summary of the nominee's activities should include both the degree of involvement in and results of participation as a member of 4-H and the 4-H Horse Program.

Examples of nominee involvement can include but is not limited to such activities as: 4-H horse judging; quiz bowl; 4-H horse show participation; involvement with a 4-H club and club leadership; community service or involvement at the county level. In addition, leaders should consider the results of participation, discussing how the nominee's experiences in 4-H and the 4-H Horse Program have helped them grow and mature.
