- PEP
 - Dropping sessions from 10 to 8. 8 Sessions in the spring, 8 in the fall
 - Held at the Drakes barn, Black Tie Ranch
 - Marsh Rd south side of 26 mile road
 - 3 walkers per rider, 1 to lead, 2 as side walkers
 - About 8 riders per each 45 minute time slot, 2 time slots per day
 - 8 week program
 - PEP IS counted for community service
 - It has its own project code for the riders
 - Training is April 1st 6:30 – 7:30 at the Black Tie Ranch
 - Must be 14 or older to walk the horses
 - Younger people can still help
 - First session is April 22, Wed 6- 6:45 for first session 6:45 – 7:45 for the second session
 - People needed there about 5:30p to help set up, tack horses, check in riders
 - There are not enough volunteers. Idea: Have clubs take PEP for 1 week
 - A sign up sheet was passed around: April 22 – Hoofbeats & More and Washington Raiders; April 29 – Ray's Riding Rascals; May 6 – Pirates and Midnite Riders; May 13 – Romeo Rough Riders; May 20 – A Little Tacky and Just For Fun.
 - People can be trained on the day of the session if they arrive early
