Basics of vegetable gardening class offered

Macomb County residents interested in lowering their grocery bills by starting a home garden are encouraged to attend the Vegetable Gardening Basics for New Gardeners Class offered by Macomb County MSU Extension (MSUE).

The program is especially for those new to gardening and will be taught by Hannah Stevens, an extension educator with over 25 years experience working with farmers and home gardeners.

Participants will learn the basics of planning a garden, selecting a good site, what crops and how much to plant, preparing and maintaining the garden, and how to have a bountiful harvest.

The program runs from 6-9 p.m. Monday, April 27, at the MSUE offices, 21885 Dunham Rd. (near entrance E), in Clinton Township.

There is a \$5 fee which covers materials and refreshments.
