The St. Clair County Intermediate School District – Early On provided additional funds for the purchase of toys for children with special needs. We are excited by the opportunity to offer excellent resources – books, videos and toys – to the child care providers and parents of Macomb and St. Clair Counties.

Materials may be borrowed from the Resource Center for a period of one month. A \$20.00 deposit (CHECKS ONLY PLEASE) is required and refunded to the borrower when the materials are returned. Five (5) items may be borrowed per visit and no more than 2 videos can be checked out at one time. An additional video may be borrowed with another deposit of \$20.00. There will be a fee of \$1.00 per day for late returns.

Many bulletins are also available at no charge or for a minimal fee on a variety of topics relating to children and child care. Up to ten NAEYC or Extension pamphlets can be taken at no charge, additional pamphlets are \$0.50 per item.

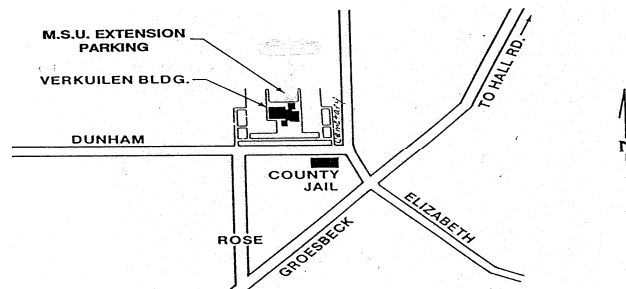
A laminating machine is also available for \$.20 per foot. Please call ahead to schedule usage of this machine.

I understand that 4C materials must be returned on due dates in good condition. Items may be borrowed for a period of one month. There will be a fee of \$1.00 per day for items returned after the due date. Please contact the 4C office to schedule a date and time when you will be returning the borrowed materials.

I understand that 4C equipment which is directly used by children must be sanitized with bleach water solution and rinsed before return. (Bleach water solution formula is 1 tsp. Bleach to 1 quart water.) Air dry equipment after it has been cleaned.
