### **Flu Vaccine Clinic at New Haven High School**

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, flu activity in the U.S. peaks in January, February and March. To protect against this serious and sometime fatal disease, the CDC recommends an annual flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older.

Just in time to fend off the bug, the Macomb County Health Department will hold a vaccination clinic from 2 to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 10, 2012 at New Haven High School. Three types of vaccines will be available:

- The **Intradermal Fluzone®** (using a new, FDA-approved micro-needle) will be offered at no cost to uninsured/underinsured adult's age 19 through 64. These free shots are available on a first-come, first-served basis for the first three hundred people.
- The more traditional **intramuscular** shot is available for \$15, payable by cash or check. The fee will be billed for residents enrolled in Medicare Part B or Medicaid, provided that a program ID card and a valid driver's license or other form of photo identification is presented. HAP Medicare clients must pay the fee or obtain the vaccine at their in-network medical provider.
- The **nasal mist spray**, available for healthy people age 2 through 49 years, will also be available for a fee of \$15.

Children under the age of 19 without insurance coverage for flu vaccine can receive a vaccine for an administrative fee of \$8.

New Haven High School is located at 57700 Gratiot Avenue. The clinic will be in the cafeteria. For more information, please call (586) 469-5372.
