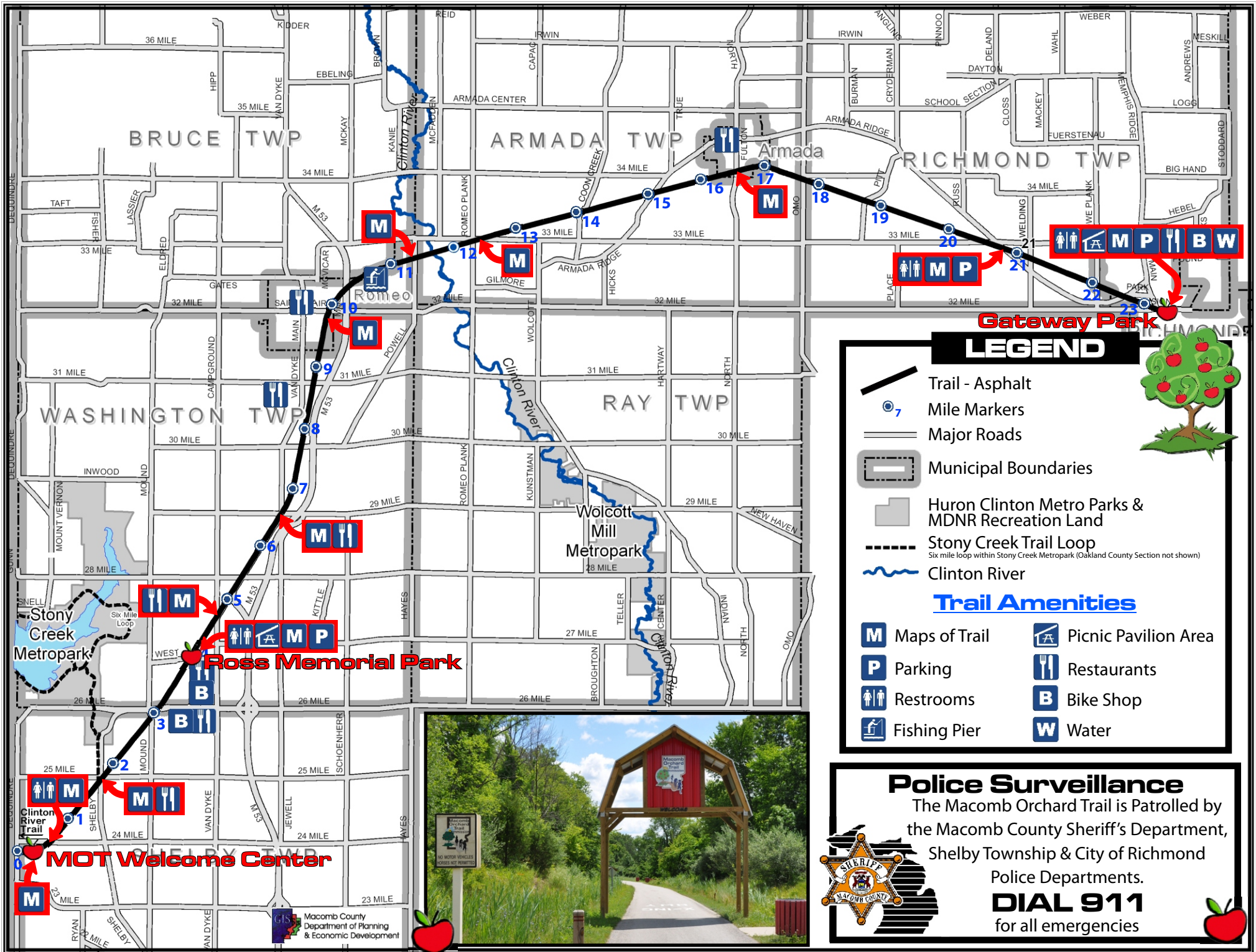

Trail Rules

-  Trail open one hour before sunrise until one hour after sunset
-  No motorized vehicles
-  Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult
-  Walkers have the right of way; bikes, skates, and skateboards yield to pedestrians
-  Always pass to the left; no excessive speeding
-  Do not block the trail
-  All pets must be kept on a leash and under control
-  Owners must clean up after pets
-  No littering
-  No alcoholic beverages allowed
-  Users must stop at all crossings
-  Climbing on bridges and railings is prohibited
-  Respect the privacy of adjacent home owners
-  Camping and fires prohibited
-  Firearms and hunting are prohibited
