Senior Outreach Day scheduled for Macomb Township

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. –Macomb County Senior Citizen Services will host a Senior Outreach Day on Wednesday, Nov. 16, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m, in Macomb Township.

Annual seasonal Flu and pneumonia vaccines, blood pressure, glucose, outdated medication disposal and information of interest to senior citizens will be available. The clinic will be held at the Macomb Township Parks and Recreation Center, 19925 - 23 Mile Road.

The Macomb County Health Department will offer flu vaccinations to all adults and to children who are at least 6 months old.

The fee may be billed to Medicare Part B or Medicaid for those who are enrolled in those programs. Medicare or Medicaid billing requires recipients to show their program ID card and a valid driver's license or other form of photo identification. HAP Medicare clients must pay the fee or obtain the vaccine at their in-network medical provider.

For those without these insurances, it is a \$15 charge for each flu vaccination and a \$30 charge for each pneumonia vaccination payable with cash or check. Debit and credit cards are not accepted.

You can help the environment by bringing unneeded or expired non-narcotic medication for proper disposal by the health department's Environmental Health Division. Bring the drugs in a nondescript container with no identifying information such as a plastic bag.
