“Are You Ready to Buy a Home?”-- Find out at MSU Extension class

This free class from MSU Extension will help you determine what price you can afford to pay for a home given your income, your debt and your credit scores. You will also need to consider whether you have the necessary commitment to maintain a home.

Government and community programs are available to assist people with low to moderate incomes who are mortgage-eligible to purchase their first home. These programs define first-time homebuyers as those who have never owned a home, or those who have not owned a home for the past three years. Several programs will be discussed, such as the Michigan State Housing Development Authority loan and down payment assistance program, the Macomb County American Dream and Individual Development Account programs, the City of Warren Neighborhood Stabilization Program, and Habitat for Humanity.

MSU Extension is offering *Are You Ready to Buy a Home?* from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 29, 2011 at the Mount Clemens Public Library, 150 Cass Avenue (between Gratiot and Groesbeck) in Mount Clemens.
