Board of Commissioners Forms Justice & Public Safety Committee

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. — Macomb County Board of Commissioners voted at its August 25, 2011 full board meeting to create the Justice & Public Safety Committee, chaired by Commissioner Phil DiMaria.

The committee combines the duties of the Courts & Clerk/Register of Deeds Committee and the Public Safety Committee into one committee. The committee is comprised of DiMaria, Vice-Chair Joe Sabatini, Don Brown, Fred Miller, Jim Carabelli, Roland Frascchetti, Marv Sauger, Bob Smith, Ray Gralewski, and Kathy Vosburg.

DiMaria, who previously chaired the Public Safety Committee and has chaired a Justice and Public Safety committee as part of previous boards, said the merger of committees is logical.

“Because of the natural relationship between public safety and the courts, I think this is a more efficient way to operate, rather than having two separate committees,” he said. “I look forward to all of the good work will do as part of the Justice & Public Safety Committee.”

The committee will meet on the dates and times previously scheduled through the year for the Public Safety Committee: at 9 a.m. on September 6, October 11, November 1 and December 5.

“This is just one way the Board is responding to our new role in county government,” said Board Chair Kathy D. Vosburg. “We are continually looking for ways to streamline government while still being productive and proactive.”
