Board of Commissioners Urges Local Support on “Small Business Saturday”

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. — To honor the significance and impact of small businesses on our local economy, the Macomb County Board of Commissioners has proclaimed November 26, 2011 “Small Business Saturday” in Macomb County.

The Board passed a proclamation in support of “Small Business Saturday” at its full board meeting on Thursday, urging county residents to spend their earnings locally and “support (local) businesses that create jobs, boost our (local) economy and preserve our neighborhoods.”

According to the United States Small Business Administration, there are currently 28 million small businesses in the U.S. last year and those businesses created 65-percent of net new jobs during the past two decades.

Vosburg. “Purchasing goods and services within Macomb County benefits both our businesses and our residents by creating and retaining jobs, boosting our local economy, and preserving the strength of our community as a whole.”
