GROUNDBREAKING SET FOR NEW PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Groundbreaking for the new Macomb County Public Works building is scheduled for 11 a.m. Thursday, Dec. 16, at the construction site on Dunham Road just west of the VerKuijen Building in Clinton Township.

County Board of Commissioners Chair Nancy White; Public Works Commissioner Anthony Marrocco; Nasser Beydoun, president Project Control Systems Inc., the general contractor; Dominic Abbate, president of Wakely Associates Inc., project architect; and Keith Rengert, chairman of the County Board's Operational Services Committee, will preside over the ceremony.

When completed in 12 to 18 months, the \$5.6 million, 18,000-square-foot new building will help the Public Works Office provide services to county residents even more efficiently.
