Mount Clemens resident Chrystal Sansbury today will take possession of a new home that was made possible by the Macomb County HOME Program. The HOME Program is designed to provide decent, affordable housing for low-income families. In Macomb County, the program typically assists income-eligible families perform major repairs.

After an unscrupulous mortgage company and a contractor victimized Ms. Sansbury, her previous home was condemned. The Macomb County HOME Program worked over the past six months to leverage community and federal resources that resulted in a new home for the single mother. More than 40 private and public businesses and entities worked with Macomb County to make the new home possible. She will receive the keys to her home from officials of the Macomb County Department of Planning & Economic Development, which operates the HOME Program.
