## **OCTOBER SENIOR OUTREACH DAY SCHEDULED FOR STERLING HEIGHTS**

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The Macomb County Department of Senior Citizen Services with the support of County Commissioner Diana Kolakowski will coordinate an Outreach Day from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 26, at St. Rene Church.

Health screenings and vital information of interest to senior citizens will be offered at this clinic. St. Rene Church is located at 35955 Ryan Road, Sterling Heights.

Due to the shortage of the influenza vaccine, the Macomb County Health Department will not administer flu vaccinations at this event. The following free services will be offered to seniors at this site: Macomb County Discount Cards, blood pressure and cholesterol tests, height, weight and cardiovascular disease risk assessment, glaucoma screening and bone density tests. Free radon test kits for the home also will be available.
