MACOMB COUNTY PURCHASES MOUNT CLEMENS PROPERTIES

Macomb County purchased three vacant properties adjacent to the south side of the Administration Building in Mount Clemens to accommodate future needs. The properties at 45, 63 and 77 South Main St. were purchased from Mount Clemens Medea Center LLC for \$2.8 million.

“As Macomb County’s population and economic base expands, we will eventually need to expand our services and office space,” said Nancy White, chair of the Board of Commissioners. “Even though we have no specific plans to develop the property at this time, this is a proactive purchase that will allow us to grow while keeping our offices in a unified footprint in downtown Mount Clemens.”

The properties include a former industrial equipment company, a former transmission repair shop and a former bank.

Macomb County will raze the three dilapidated buildings and use part of the reclaimed land to provide much-needed parking for county employees and citizens doing business with county departments. This will free up parking space for guests of downtown Mount Clemens shops and restaurants.

“The purchase of this property demonstrates Macomb County’s ongoing commitment to the city of Mount Clemens by providing for the future growth of the county’s downtown campus,” White said.
