Macomb County Meals on Wheels seeks volunteers

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Volunteers are needed to deliver meals to frail, homebound senior citizens in Clinton Township, Eastpointe, Richmond, Roseville, St. Clair Shores, Utica and Warren.

People who volunteer for Macomb County's Meals on Wheels program are asked to drive a 90-minute lunchtime route twice a month during weekdays.

The Macomb County Community Services Agency (MCCSA), which administers Meals on Wheels, also needs substitute drivers in all areas of the county.
