Macomb County Library hosts program on safe online selling

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. – Successful online sellers and employees of the U.S. Postal Service will show Macomb County Library guests how to sell, trade and ship safely on eBay.

The program runs from 10 a.m. to noon Friday, July 27, at the Macomb County Library, 16480 Hall Road (near Garfield) in Clinton Township.

Participants will learn how to create improved listings with better descriptions and photography. They also will get tips on pricing; opening and using PayPal accounts to accept secure online payments, and monitoring and completing transactions.

Shipping and packaging tips also will be highlighted, including mailing online using the U.S. Postal Service's "Click-N-Ship" program with free package pickup.
