## **Free genealogy classes at Macomb County Library**

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. – The Macomb County Library commemorates Family History Month in October by offering two free classes on how to use a computer to research ancestors.

The classes about online genealogy searches will be held in the library's computer lab and are scheduled for 10 a.m. to noon Saturday, Oct. 6; and 7 to 9 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 11. Both classes are the same, so guests should sign up for only one session.

People attending the classes will learn how to use online databases and how to access local, regional, state and national genealogical Web sites. Guests also will receive free genealogy charts and the booklet "Beginning Your Genealogy Research."

Participants are asked to bring the name of a male ancestor who was living in the United States in 1930.

The classes are free, but seating is limited and registration is required. Call Bill Luft at 586-412-5986, to register or for further information. The library is located at 16480 Hall Road, west of Garfield, in Clinton Township.
