Flu shots offered at Freedom Hill County Park

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The Macomb County Health Department is sponsoring a two-day clinic for people who want a vaccination to protect them during flu season. Flu shots will be available for adults and for children at least 6 months old.

The clinics run from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 11; and 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Friday, Oct. 12 at Freedom Hill County Park, 15000 Metropolitan Parkway in Sterling Heights.

A \$15 charge for each vaccination is payable with cash or check. The fee may also be billed to Medicare Part B or Medicaid for residents who are enrolled in those programs. Medicare or Medicaid billing requires recipients to show their ID card for the program and a valid driver's license or other form of photo identification.

People with access to the Internet can download vaccine information forms and consent forms from: www.macombcountymi.gov/publichealth . Completing the consent form in advance will save time at Freedom Hill.
