## **Macomb County Library hosts programs on safe online selling**

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. – Successful online sellers and employees of the U.S. Postal Service will teach Macomb County Library guests how to sell, trade and ship safely in cyberspace.

Two sessions of this popular program are being offered on Friday, Oct. 19. The first session is 10 a.m. to noon, the second session 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. The Macomb County Library is located at 16480 Hall Road near Garfield Road in Clinton Township.

Participants will learn how to create improved listings with better descriptions and photographs. They also will get tips on pricing, opening and using PayPal accounts to accept secure online payments and monitoring and completing online transactions.

Shipping and packaging tips also will be highlighted, including how to mail online using the U.S. Postal Service's "Click-N-Ship" program with free package pickup.
