Prescription help offered for qualifying Macomb County senior citizens

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Macomb County senior citizens age 60 and older are invited to an event to meet with professionals to see if they qualify for low-cost or free medications through the Prescription Resource Network (PRN).

The event is scheduled for 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Friday, Nov. 16, at Mount Calvary Lutheran Church, 8129 Packard Ave., Warren. The church is south of 9 Mile Road and east of Van Dyke Avenue. Advisors will be available to answer questions.

PRN, which helps seniors obtain the prescriptions they need, is a collaborative effort between the Macomb County Department of Senior Citizen Services and Henry Ford Macomb Hospitals.
