Macomb County wins top award for emergency preparedness

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The Michigan Emergency Management Association (MEMA) honored Macomb County’s top emergency preparedness official as its 2007 Coordinator of the Year.

Vicki Wolber of Roseville, acting director of the Macomb County Emergency Management & Communications Department, earned the award for jurisdictions with more than 60,000 residents. The department is responsible for working with local law enforcement agencies, fire departments, first responders and other officials to prepare responses to natural or man-made disasters.

“It is reassuring to know we have such capable people looking out for our well-being in case an emergency happens,” said William Crouchman, chairman of the Macomb County Board of Commissioners.

Wolber earned the award in voting by her peers in MEMA who weighed only their accomplishments; nominees were not identified by name or jurisdiction.
