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Household hazardous waste collection in Mount Clemens

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The Macomb County Health Department is hosting a household hazardous waste collection from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday, June 21, in the department's parking lot, 43525 Elizabeth Road in Mount Clemens.

Macomb County residents may drop off unwanted or unused household chemicals, pesticides and herbicides. Automotive products (motor oil and oil filters, gasoline, battery acid and fluids), garden products (pesticides, poisons, sprays and dusts) and household products (oven cleaners, pool chemicals, photography chemicals, fluorescent tubes, household batteries, oil based paint and solvents) will be accepted.

One free environmentally friendly fluorescent tube or compact fluorescent light, per household, will be exchanged for any fluorescent tube delivered.

Macomb County residents only also may drop off unwanted computers, monitors, scanners, printers and keyboards. Schools and businesses are not allowed to in this one-time, EPA-funded computer collection.

Other types of electronic equipment such as televisions, radios and appliances will not be accepted.

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The following items also will not be accepted: smoke detectors, latex paint, explosives, ammunition and flares. Do not mix chemicals or transport leaking containers.

Unwanted medications, including narcotics, will be accepted. Please remove pills from the bottles and place them in a clear plastic bag. The Macomb County Sheriff's Office will be accepting controlled substances such as narcotic painkillers/stimulants at this site, but must be kept in a separate plastic bag.
