Prescription help offered for qualifying Macomb County senior citizens

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Macomb County senior citizens age 60 and older are invited to meet with professionals in St. Clair Shores to see if they qualify for low-cost or free medications through the Prescription Resource Network (PRN).

People may meet with PRN advisors from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 8 at, St. Clair Shores Senior Center, 20000 Stephens Drive.

PRN, which helps seniors obtain the prescriptions they need, is a collaborative effort between the Macomb County Department of Senior Citizen Services Department and Henry Ford Macomb Hospitals.
