Commissioner Joan Flynn re-appointed to two NACo committees

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Commissioner Joan Flynn of Warren was re-appointed to serve on two committees of the National Association of Counties (NACo) and was honored for her previous service to the organization.
