Walk for Warmth raises funds to heat homes

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – Macomb County Community Services Agency (MCCSA) is seeking walkers and donations for its 20th annual Walk for Warmth event on Saturday, February 20th. The 3-mile Walk will begin and end at St. Therese of Lisieux Parish, located at 48115 Schoenherr Road in Shelby Township. Funds raised assist income-eligible families, individuals and senior citizens facing heat shut-off or those in need of furnace repair or replacement.

Registration will begin at 9 a.m. and the walk starts at 10 a.m. Walkers may enjoy a continental breakfast before participating in the 3-mile event. Transportation is available if a walker is unable to complete the route. Lunch and door prizes follow completion of the walk.

Each participating walker must have a minimum pledge total of \$20. Walkers who raise more than \$500 in pledges are eligible for gift certificates in amounts relative to the pledge amount raised. Walkers must turn in all their pledges the day of the walk to be eligible for gift certificates.
