County seeks members for Cobo Citizens Advisory Council

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. – The Macomb County Board of Commissioners is seeking to fill two seats on the newly-formed Cobo Citizen’s Advisory Council. Each appointment is for a term of 4-years and residents of Macomb County, who are not state or local elected officials, are eligible to apply.

The mandates set forth by the state legislature in the Regional Convention Facility Authority Act (Public Act 554 of 2008) provided for the expansion of Cobo Hall and created the Cobo Authority. In addition to the Authority that votes and oversees operations at Cobo, the law establishes a citizen’s advisory council. The Council will consist of eight members, two each from Macomb, Oakland and Wayne counties as well as the City of Detroit. The Council is a non-voting advisory panel designed to provide public input on the impact of redevelopment and management issues at Cobo.

Those wishing to apply are encouraged to submit application materials before March 11. The selections will be made by appointment of the Chair and also by a vote of the Board of Commissioners at their Full Board Meeting on March 25 at 7 p.m.
