Service Providers Collaborate to Offer Assistance

WASHINGTON, Mich. – Macomb County Community Services Agency (MCCSA) now offers appointments for assistance at a location in Washington, Michigan. MCCSA Community Action Center staff now assists people with available services at this location in collaboration with host site Samaritan House.

MCCSA staff work with Macomb County residents in need of help with utility shut off notices, eviction prevention and applying for home weatherization services. Senior citizens can also be certified for Focus: HOPE food distribution at this location.
