"Vaccine-preventable diseases have not gone away. In fact, three cases of tetanus were recently reported in Michigan," said Dr. Kevin P. Lokar, Medical Director with the Macomb County Health Department. New school immunization rules went into effect last September for children entering 6th grade, as well as for all students 11-18 years of age changing school districts.

Beat the back-to-school rush and get your children’s school shots NOW!

Macomb County Health Department has added additional evening and weekend clinic hours during August to meet immunization demand before the start of the school.
