County Executive Mark Hackel Names New Assistant County Executive

Macomb County Executive Mark A. Hackel today appointed Pamela J. Lavers of Harrison Township as an Assistant County Executive in the Office of County Executive (OCE).

She previously served as executive liaison officer in the office. In her new role, Lavers will lead marketing, communications and organizational development for the 15 county departments the executive office oversees. In addition, she will continue to serve as the county executive's liaison with the Board of Commissioners and will oversee the appointment process for the county executive's appointments to 21 boards and commissions.

"Pam brings a wealth of municipal management experience to the position," said Hackel. "She has demonstrated tremendous ability and a thorough knowledge of county operations."

Hackel added that Lavers has played a major role in establishing Macomb County's new form of county government. "She has also helped advance key programs like our New Blue Economy initiative and the county's new web-based government transparency effort," he said.

Prior to joining the OCE in January, Lavers served as assistant city manager and city clerk for the City of Fraser for seven years. She was directly responsible for human resources, public information, and city elections while also providing management oversight and budgeting support for the city. She joined Fraser in 1995 as an administrative aide, and was later promoted to deputy clerk.

Before joining Fraser, Lavers worked as executive assistant for Comcast Cablevision. Her areas of focus during her 15 years with Comcast were administrative, public relations and marketing.

Lavers earned her bachelor's degree in community development and public administration from Central Michigan University, and her master's degree in public administration, also from CMU.
