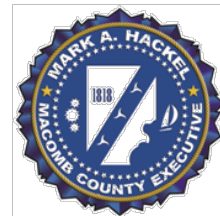

Moravian bridge to open October 14th

- WHO:** Macomb County Executive Mark A. Hackel
Macomb County Director of Roads Robert Hoepfner

- WHAT:** Ribbon-cutting ceremony to officially open the new Moravian Road Bridge in Clinton Township
- WHEN:** Friday, October 14, 2011
NOTE: Time Change: 2:00 p.m.
- WHERE:** 40500 Moravian Drive, Clinton Township, MI 48036
Ceremony will be held next to the bridge at this location
Media parking in George George Memorial Park
- WHY:** The Moravian bridge was originally built in 1927 when Calvin Coolidge was President of the United States. It spans the Clinton River between Cass Avenue and Harrington. The bridge was replaced at a cost of \$2.4 million and accommodates approximately 8,500 vehicles daily. A 10-foot wide hike/bike path to accommodate pedestrian traffic was also added. Moravian Drive was built in 1782 and is one of the oldest non-military roads in Michigan.
