Financial stress relief for municipal managers

EAST LANSING, Mich. – It's no secret that Michigan municipalities are facing considerable fiscal stress due to the current economic climate. To help southeastern Michigan fiscal managers handle the challenges facing them, Michigan State University (MSU) Extension is sponsoring workshops to explore practical strategies for dealing with:

- reducing costs and improving productivity
- government contracting management
- health care cost containment
- interlocal consolidation and turnaround plans

These sessions will be held in Warren on October 17 and (repeated) in Taylor on November 2. Both programs will run from 10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The Warren session will be held at DeCarlo's Banquet and Convention Center and the Taylor event will take place at the Taylor Sportsplex.
