## **Board of Commissioners Seeks Volunteer Nominations**

MOUNT CLEMENS, Mich. — The Macomb County Board of Commissioners is seeking nominations for county residents who make a difference in the community by giving their talents and time as volunteers. Anyone who donated at least 150 volunteer hours to an organization or cause during 2010 is eligible for recognition. Nominees must be a resident of Macomb County, but their work may be performed anywhere in southeast Michigan.

“Volunteers are an essential part of our community,” said Board of Commissioners Chair Kathy D. Vosburg. “Their efforts help keep so many vital services in the community going without fail, and the Board commends their willingness and generosity to give of their time and energy .”

Of the nominees, 100 of the most outstanding volunteers will be selected and recognized at a future Board of Commissioners meeting.

Nominations must be submitted by April 29, 2011. While most nominations come from churches, schools, hospitals, charitable organizations, civic, veteran, and senior groups that know a special person whose efforts made a difference, anyone is eligible to submit a potential honoree.
