## **Macomb County Library to host passport fair**

CLINTON TOWNSHIP, Mich. – Macomb County residents who would like a passport but haven't had the time to get one are encouraged to visit a passport fair at the Macomb County Library.

Postmaster Valerie Miller is sponsoring a one-stop fair from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Friday, Oct. 27. Applicants planning to travel overseas can get everything they need during their lunch hour, and complete all the steps necessary to get a passport.

Those seeking a passport must appear in person and bring two qualifying forms of identification. Acceptable identification includes a birth certificate with official raised seal, a current driver's license, a state ID card or a naturalization certificate.

Applicants also should bring two passport-size photos (2 inches by 2 inches). The postmaster will take photos during the fair for a fee of \$15.

Passport fees, payable to the U.S. Department of State, are \$67 for adults and \$52 for children younger than 16. There also is an execution fee of \$30 per applicant payable to the postmaster.
