## **Book discussion group meets at Macomb County Library**

Cooper is the host of “Anderson Cooper 360 Degrees,” a fast-paced alternative news program on CNN which boasts a 360-degree look at world events.

This biography tells of war and natural disasters, interspersed with many personal issues including the suicide of his brother, the death of his father and challenges faced by his famous mother, Gloria Vanderbilt.
