Sinclair is a graduate of the National Theatre School of Canada and holds a Master of Arts degree in Theatre from the University of Denver. He has also studied at the Royal Academy of Dramatic Arts in London, England and at the National Film Board of Canada.

Sinclair is a recipient of the Sir Tyrone Guthrie Award for acting at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival in Ontario, Sinclair has performed in Cuba, Denmark, Holland, Poland and the Moscow Art Theatre in Russia. He now is artistic director of the Children of Erin Theatre Company in Ontario. Canada.
