Freedom Hill H1N1 Vaccination Clinic

Pregnant Women and Eligible Members of Their Households ONLY

**Tuesday, November 17
Noon – 7:00 PM**

Any woman who knows she is pregnant, regardless of trimester, is eligible to receive the injectable form of the H1N1 vaccine. Thimerosal-free vaccine will be available.

Persons accompanying the pregnant woman to this clinic are also eligible to receive the H1N1 vaccine **IF** they are living in the pregnant woman's household **AND** they fall into one of the following groups:

- Age six months through 24 years of age
- Age 25 through 64 with a chronic medical condition
- Health care worker or EMS provider
- If there is already an infant under six months of age in the household

Household members may be offered either the injectable or intranasal form of the H1N1 vaccine. They are equally safe and effective.
