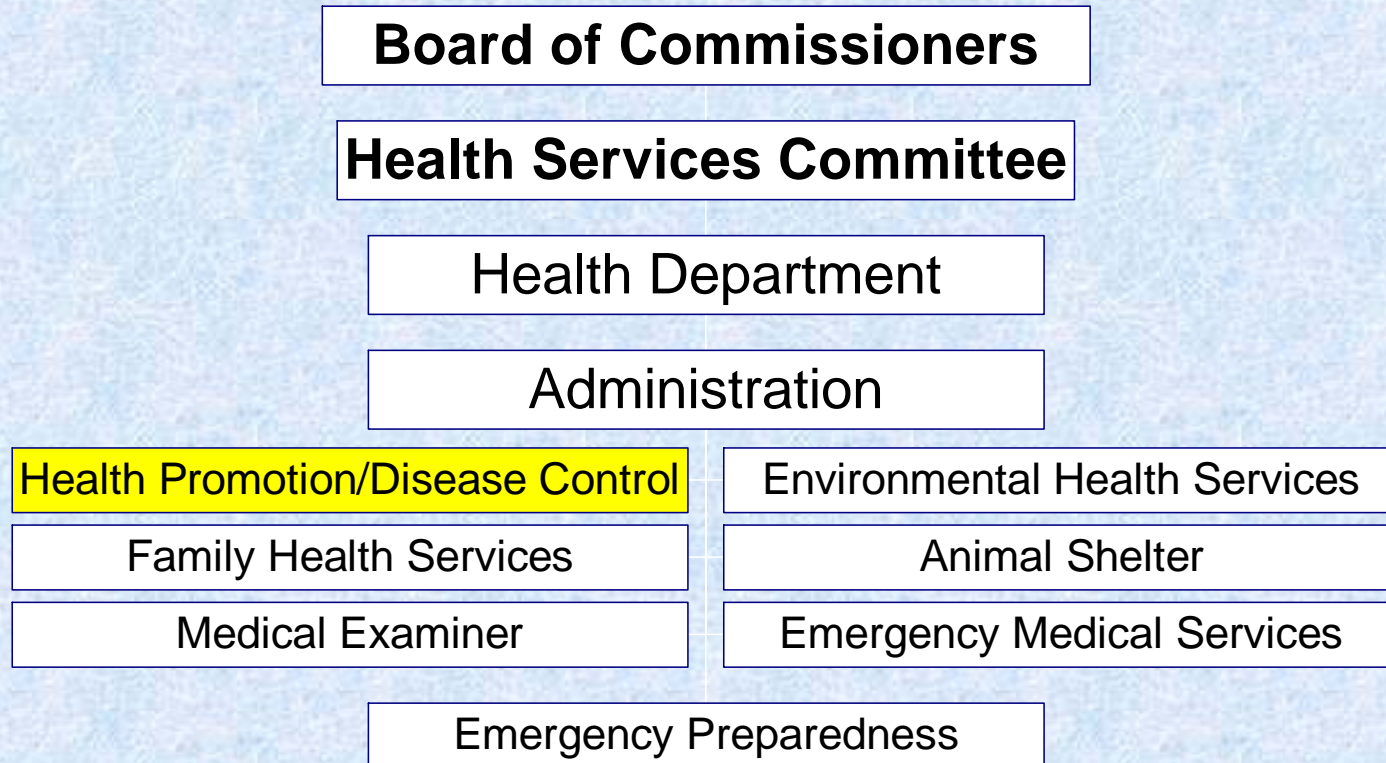
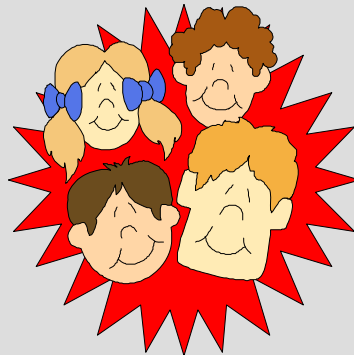


Organizational Chart

The Health Promotion/Disease Control Division develops community-based health promotion activities and implements policies and procedures to control both communicable and chronic diseases in Macomb County.

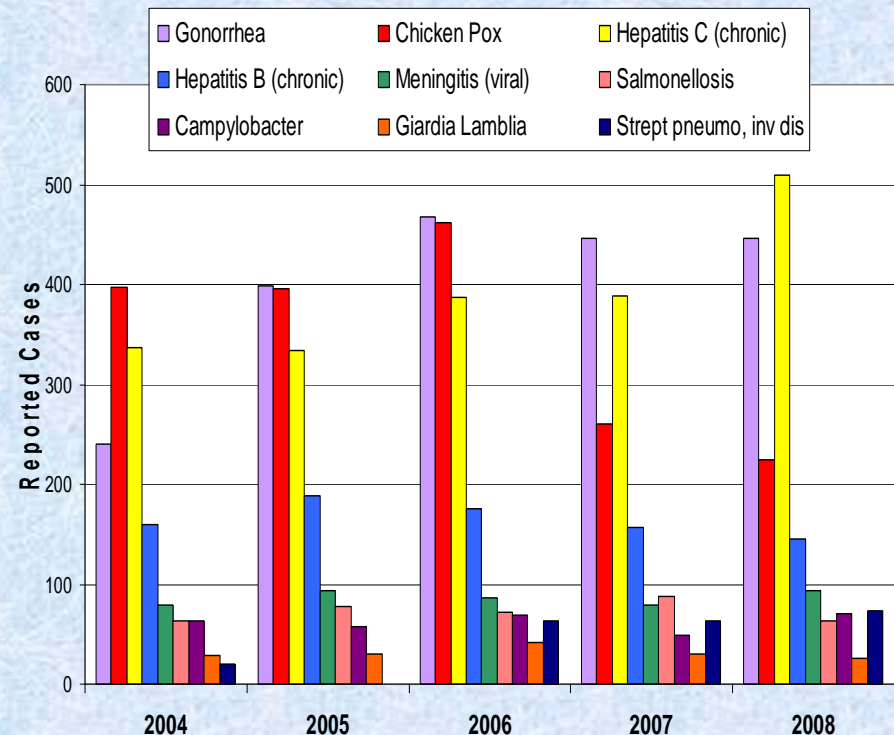
Communicable Disease Investigation

Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978

- ◆ Monitors the incidence of reportable communicable diseases.
- ◆ Investigates reportable communicable diseases, including foodborne illnesses.
- ◆ Reports communicable diseases to State public health authorities.
- ◆ Provides recommendations for contacts to communicable diseases.
- ◆ Provides foreign travel information and referral for vaccination.

Leading Communicable Diseases 2004-2008



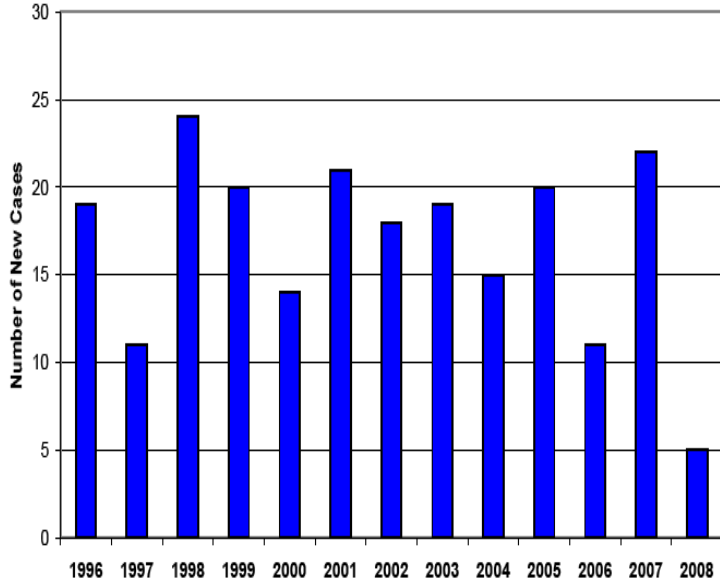

Tuberculosis Control

Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978

TB Cases; Macomb County



- ◆ Provides diagnosis, treatment, case management and clinical consultation services for individuals infected with or actively ill from *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*.
- ◆ Conducts surveillance and reporting of active cases to the State.
- ◆ Conducts contact investigation for individuals who may have been exposed to an active case of Tuberculosis.
- ◆ Provides Directly Observed Therapy (DOT) for select individuals.
