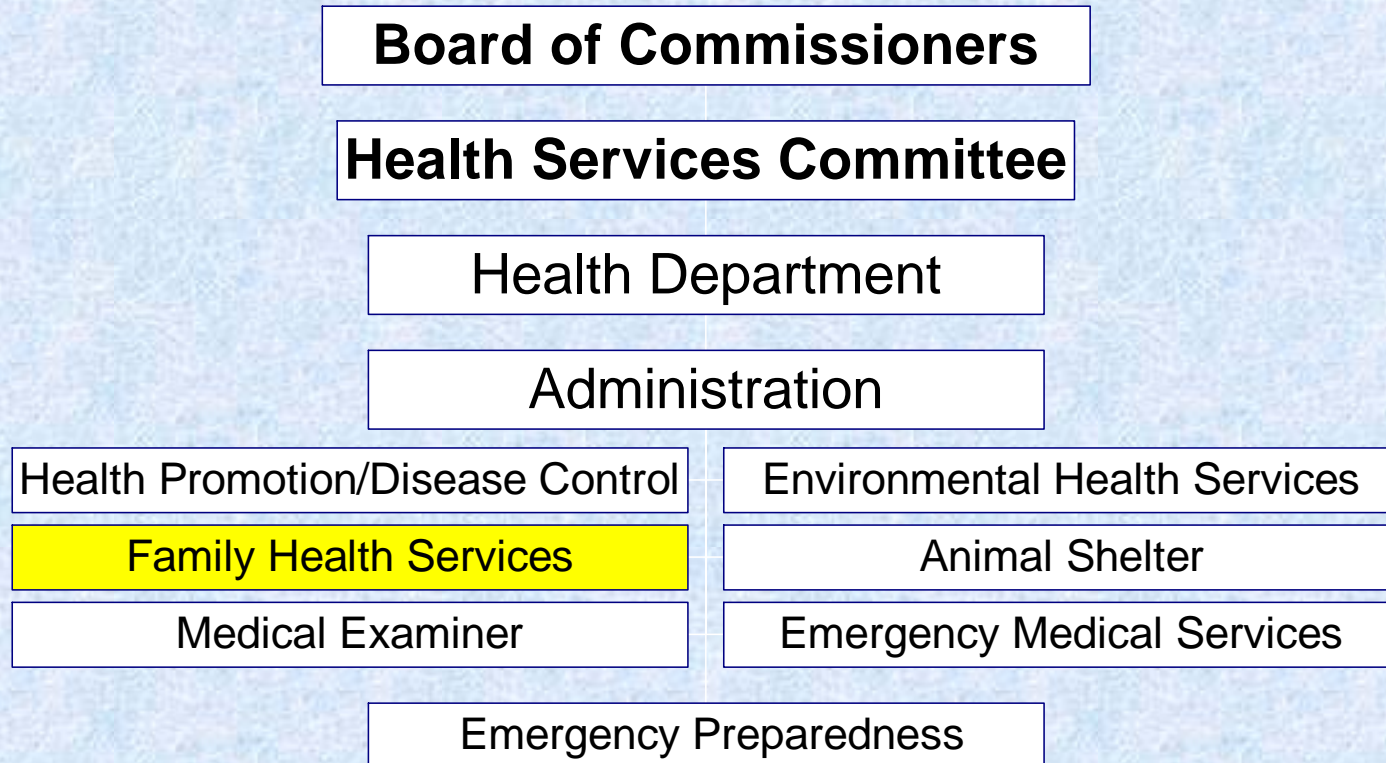
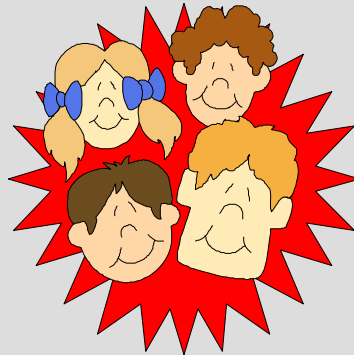


Organizational Chart

Family Health Services

The Family Health Services Division improves, promotes and protects the public's health concerns across the age continuum through services oriented toward prevention, early detection, evaluation and referral, in collaboration with other public and private agencies.

Children's Special Health Care Services

Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978
- Title V

- ◆ Assists families to meet the needs of children with special needs.
- ◆ Services include payments for specialty care, newborn testing, genetic counseling and others.
- ◆ Eligibility guidelines:
 - *Families with children under 21 years of age*
 - *All persons with Cystic Fibrosis and Hemophilia*

Public Health Nursing

- ◆ Family centered health promotion, assessment & education services in Macomb County homes & communities.
- ◆ Provides maternal/child health information & education including parenting, infant care, growth & development, nutrition, safety, immunizations and others.
- ◆ Answers general health risk concerns & links individuals & families to resources & agencies.
- ◆ A phone duty nurse is available during normal business hours to answer general questions.

Women Infants and Children (WIC) Supplemental Nutrition Program

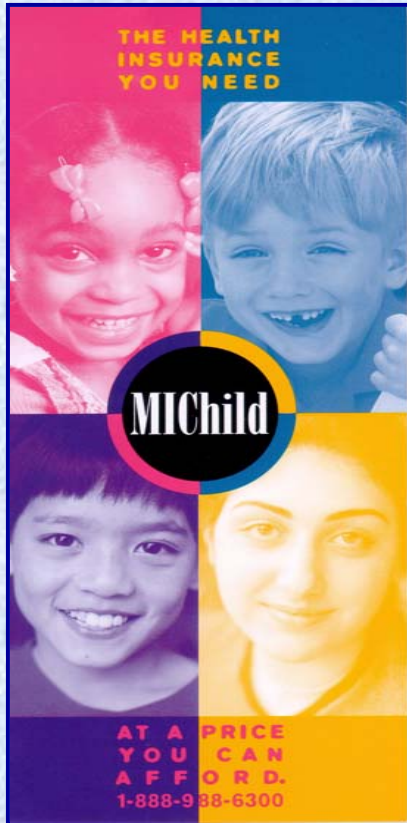
Statutory Authority:

- Federal Public Law 95 - 627
- Section 17 of Child Nutrition Act
- ◆ Supplemental foods, nutrition education, breastfeeding promotion and support and referrals to health care and community resources provided at four (4) locations: Mt. Clemens, Warren, St. Clair Shores, New Haven
- ◆ Counseling for participants with high-risk medical conditions that require therapeutic nutrition intervention
- ◆ Teaches WIC participants how to exchange WIC food coupons at approved retail grocery stores
- ◆ Immunizations provided at most WIC sites
- ◆ Income, age & residency eligibility guidelines

MIChild/Healthy Kids/Prenatal Health Care Insurance



Statutory Authority:

- OBRA 89, P.L. 101- 239
- Title XIX
- ◆ Assists with application completion and care coordination.
- ◆ Links with providers, clinics and hospitals for medical care.
- ◆ Provides health education regarding the importance of utilizing health care coverage for prevention services.
- ◆ Income and insurance eligibility guidelines

...a free health insurance program for qualifying pregnant women, babies and children under 19 years of age

Sudden/Unexpected Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) Support

- ◆ Grief counseling and support services by specially trained public health nurses to families who have experienced a sudden or unexpected infant death.
- ◆ Presentations on risk reduction/safe sleep measures to local community groups.
- ◆ Distributes free educational materials.

Family Planning

Statutory Authority:

- Title X
- Public Act 368 of 1978
- Public Act 226 of 1997

- ◆ Reproductive health education, counseling, contraceptive management & care at three (3) Macomb County locations: *Mt. Clemens, Warren & St. Clair Shores.*
- ◆ Services are confidential, non-discriminatory & do not require a physician referral.
- ◆ Female nurse practitioners are available.
- ◆ Appointments are necessary; evening & early morning hours are available.
- ◆ Adolescents receive services without parental consent. Parent participation and/or open communication with a trusted adult is encouraged.
- ◆ Fees based on ability to pay; services not denied if unable to pay; Medicaid accepted.

Dental Clinic

Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978
- Public Act 58 of 1991

- ◆ Provides preventive and restorative dental services, excluding orthodontics
- ◆ Services at the Warren location, staffed by qualified dental professionals
- ◆ Eligibility guidelines: low income children and adults; Macomb County resident
- ◆ Accepts Medicaid eligible persons (per state program guidelines) and persons who meet income guidelines and do **not** have dental insurance

Immunizations



Statutory Authority:

- Public Act 368 of 1978
- P.L. 99 - 690 of 1986

- ◆ Vaccines available for children and adults on a walk-in basis (appointments also available on request).
- ◆ Parent/guardians required to bring all existing immunization records, social security numbers and insurance card(s).
- ◆ Children must be accompanied by an adult/legal guardian.
- ◆ Fees for vaccine administration and selected vaccines; Medicaid & Medicare accepted.
- ◆ Services provided at all health department locations and community outreach sites (Romeo, Richmond,). Evening hours available.
